**Report on the 3rd Living Lab Stakeholder Meeting within the TERRAIN Project
3 June 2026
Regional Development Agency South Banat, Pančevo**

The third Living Lab stakeholder meeting within the framework of the project “*Twinning and Engagement in net-zero tRanport tRAnsItioN - TERRAIN*” was held on 3 June 2026 at the premises of the Regional Development Agency South Banat in Pančevo. The project is implemented under the INTERREG IPA ADRION Programme. The Regional Development Agency South Banat participates in the project as a project partner, while the City of Pančevo is involved as an associated partner.

The meeting brought together representatives of the City Administration of Pančevo, the Public Enterprise Urbanism Pančevo, the public transport company Pantransport Pančevo, external experts involved in the preparation of the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan (SUMP) for the City of Niš, civil society organisations, and members of the Regional Development Agency South Banat project team.



The main objective of the meeting was to present the activities and results achieved so far within the TERRAIN project, facilitate the exchange of information among relevant stakeholders, and jointly identify strategic priorities in the field of sustainable urban mobility in the City of Pančevo.

During the meeting, participants were informed about the activities implemented in the previous period, with particular emphasis on the project’s pilot action involving the installation of solar panels on five public transport buses. The initiative aims to improve the energy efficiency of public transport operations, support the decarbonisation of urban transport, and promote more sustainable urban mobility solutions. Participants were also updated on the progress of the pilot action and the upcoming project activities.



A particularly important segment of the meeting was the presentation delivered by representatives of the City Administration of Pančevo regarding the ongoing process of drafting and adopting the Urban Development Strategy of the City of Pančevo. This strategic process is being implemented with the support of the EU INTEGRA Programme and UNOPS. It was highlighted that the new strategy will address key urban development areas, including urban renewal and regeneration, landscape development, protection and enhancement of cultural and architectural heritage, energy transition, green and blue investments, climate change mitigation and adaptation, as well as sustainable and multimodal urban mobility.

Participants agreed that the TERRAIN project activities make a significant contribution to achieving the objectives of the future Urban Development Strategy, particularly in relation to promoting sustainable transport modes, developing multimodal mobility solutions, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and improving citizens' quality of life.



During the discussion, stakeholders reaffirmed the previously identified urban mobility priorities for Pančevo, including the improvement of cycling infrastructure, enhanced accessibility of public transport services, development of intermodal transport solutions, and encouragement of environmentally friendly modes of transportation.

The meeting concluded that continued cooperation among all relevant stakeholders through the Living Lab methodology remains essential to ensure their active involvement in the planning and implementation of sustainable urban mobility measures and their alignment with the strategic development framework of the City of Pančevo.



The third Living Lab meeting once again confirmed the importance of a participatory approach in defining development priorities and demonstrated the strong complementarity between the TERRAIN project activities and the preparation of the Urban Development Strategy of the City of Pančevo. Participants expressed their commitment to continuing cooperation through the Living Lab platform in order to jointly shape measures that will contribute to sustainable, inclusive, and climate-resilient urban mobility.
