The TERRAIN Snapshots are thematic sessions organised within the TERRAIN project to promote knowledge exchange, mentoring activities and the transferability of good practices among partner regions and external stakeholders. Each Snapshot focuses on specific mobility challenges and solutions related to sustainable, smart and inclusive transport systems.

Recent sessions included the **TERRAIN Snapshot on [Zagreb](#)**, presented in Sarajevo in October 2025, which explored active, shared and digital mobility initiatives in the Croatian capital, and the **TERRAIN Snapshot of the [Ljubljana Urban Region](#)**, held online in January 2026, focused on smart and digital mobility solutions and regional mobility planning.

TERRAIN partners gather in Berane for the 4th project meeting and 3rd study visit

On **March 17 and 18, 2026**, partners of the TERRAIN project gathered in **Berane**, Montenegro, for the **4th Project Meeting** and 3rd Study Visit, hosted by the Municipality of Berane.

The two-day event brought together project partners and local stakeholders to review progress, exchange knowledge, and advance joint efforts towards net-zero urban mobility in the Adriatic–Ionian region.

Webinar: Understanding Urban Mobility Dynamics in TERRAIN Areas

On **April 23, 2026**, the TERRAIN project hosted the webinar *Understanding Urban Mobility Dynamics in TERRAIN Areas*, introducing a System Dynamics approach to analysing how urban mobility systems evolve over time. Based on survey data collected across the nine TERRAIN cities, the session explored mobility behaviours, user perceptions and the key factors influencing transport choices. Participants also discovered the project's simulator, a virtual tool designed to test **different mobility scenarios** and support better-informed policy decisions.

TERRAIN Pilots driving sustainable mobility across ADRION Regions

Across the ADRION region, **TERRAIN pilots** are continuing to test innovative solutions for smarter and more **sustainable mobility**.

From solar-powered public buses in [Pančevo](#) and digital fleet management systems in [Berane](#), to traffic simulation models supporting safer street redesign in [Zagreb](#) and e-bike systems promoting micromobility in the [Ljubljana Urban Region](#), partners are turning local challenges into practical pilot actions. At the same time, educational activities in [Bologna](#) are engaging younger generations through cycling and road safety workshops, helping foster a new culture of sustainable mobility. Together, these initiatives showcase how TERRAIN is supporting the transition towards climate-conscious and people-centred transport systems across the region.

Belgrade Introduces Free Public Transport to Support Sustainable Urban Mobility

As of January 2025, the **City of Belgrade** has introduced free public transport as part of its efforts to promote more **sustainable** and **accessible urban mobility**. The initiative aims to reduce private car use, traffic congestion and greenhouse gas emissions, contributing to climate-oriented urban development. Although Belgrade is not directly involved in the TERRAIN project, the measure is particularly relevant for the wider regional context, given the strong geographical and functional connection with **Pančevo**, one of the TERRAIN partner cities.

Electric Mobility Testing in the Municipality of Dobrova–Polhov Gradec within the TERRAIN Project Pilot Activities

As part of the **TERRAIN pilot activities**, the Municipality of Dobrova–Polhov Gradec tested electric micromobility solutions during the **European Mobility Week** and **Car-Free Day**. In collaboration with Nomago and the Regional Mobility Centre of the Ljubljana Urban Region, participants experienced the Nomago Bike e-bike sharing system, promoting more sustainable and accessible urban travel. The initiative is now continuing through Living Lab activities and user feedback collection to support the development of citizen-friendly mobility solutions across the ADRION area.

Zagreb expands its public bike-sharing system

The **City of Zagreb** is expanding its public bike-sharing system, **Bajs**, as part of its broader commitment to sustainable urban mobility and active transport solutions. Connected to the TERRAIN pilot activities, the initiative aims to encourage more sustainable travel behaviours through the reallocation of urban space towards cycling and active mobility. Following growing demand and positive user feedback, the city will expand the network with additional bicycles and new stations, further supporting a greener and more accessible urban environment.
