

# First steps in the implementation of the TERRAIN project in the South Banat Region

We are pleased to share the first tangible results of the TERRAIN project implementation in the South Banat region.

The Regional Development Agency South Banat of Serbia, in cooperation with the Associate Partner City of Pančevo, has successfully initiated the first implementation activities in coordination with project partners within the “Twinning and Engagement in net-zero tRansport tRAnsltioN – TERRAIN” project, co-funded by the Interreg IPA ADRION Programme.

On 1 July 2025, following the conclusion of a formal Agreement on the provision for use of solar panels, five APOLLO BUS KIT 600 W systems were installed on public transport buses operated by Pantransport Ltd. Pančevo, as part of a pilot action aimed at testing innovative solutions in real urban conditions.



This pilot contributes to the deployment of sustainable mobility measures by integrating renewable energy sources into public transport operations. The installed systems enable a reduction in electricity consumption during vehicle start-up, improve energy efficiency during vehicle operation, and contribute to a decrease in harmful emissions by approximately 8%.

Beyond its immediate environmental benefits, the action represents a practical step towards the development of smart

and climate-neutral transport solutions, while reinforcing transnational cooperation and knowledge exchange among ADRION regions. It further supports the implementation of innovative approaches and the co-creation of sustainable mobility solutions, in line with the broader objective of establishing a collaborative framework for advancing net-zero transport systems.
